A FABARM shotgun that perfectly combines a very strong personality with innovative technical points.

A FABARM pump-action shotgun that perfectly combines a very strong personality with innovative technical points. First of all, let's note its very linear configuration, with a stock having a so-called "parallel" slope. During the shooting phase, the recoil is thus more straight and the muzzle rise is significantly lower. Ergonomics with the presence of a butt comb and a return spring in the handguard for faster and easier rearming. Let's also not forget the very innovative grenade ring system whose anchoring allows the sling carabiner to be freely moved from 9 to 12 o'clock depending on the phase of use. Precise, modern, classy, this shotgun is aimed at both demanding shooters and "home defense" use.

- Capacity: 4+1 shots allowing classification in category C.
- Non-dispersing rifled barrel, drilled in the mass, with a length of 61cm (24") integrating the steel muzzle brake.
- Cantilever type rail fixed on the barrel allowing the latter to be disassembled without requiring a new adjustment of the optics.
- Complete barrel lining.
- 7075 T6 aeronautical alloy frame.
- Carcass and liner finish: Cerakote Carbon Grey.
- Composite stock called Pro Forces with fixed comb.
- Stock length: 320 mm.
- Re-arming with return spring (removable) in the handguard.
- Adjustable and folding flip-up type nylon riser and handlebar.
- Grenadier rings allowing the anchoring of straps from 9 to 12 o'clock.
- Test pressure: 1630 Bar. compatible with steel balls.

This rifle therefore allows regular and intensive use of high-performance steel ball cartridges.

A pump-action shotgun with a muzzle brake to reduce recoil. The barrel is steel-shot tested at 1630 bars (more than the Saint-Etienne test). It is therefore possible to use High Performance steel-shot cartridges in this shotgun.

A rifle with a very straight and linear stock configuration, called "parallel slope" allowing the shooter to always have a similar position of his cheek on the stock, even in the event of a series of intensive shots or rapid aiming. The cantilever fixed directly on the barrel, is designed to support optics that can have a significant weight; It offers a robust fixation and allows the adjustment of the optics to be maintained even after disassembling the rifle. The specific profile of the rubber butt plate contributes to having a natural and comfortable shooting posture. The barrel has a very long rifling pitch to allow tight patterns, the magazine tube has a capacity of 4 + 1 cartridges, two essential characteristics to allow this attractive MARTIAL CANTILEVER to be in category C.

Precise, modern, classy, this rifle is aimed at both demanding shooters and "home defense" use.
