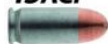

Kimber 1911 pistols are among the most popular among sporting shooters.

TLE TFS (Threaded for Suppression) models feature threaded barrels for the addition of a sound suppressor.

- 5.25" (12.7cm) barrel in Match quality steel with a rifling pitch of 1:16" (406mm, rifling on the left)
- .578 x 28 thread for adding a sound moderator (silent)
- Steel slide with deep grip grooves
- Flat Dark Earth finish
- Fixed rear sight and front sight with 3 phosphorescent white dot sights, enhanced for sound reduction
- Aluminum trigger tail
- Openwork hammer
- Grip G10 (fiberglass laminate) textured
- Picatinny rail for accessory mounting

G10 pistol grips are grip plates made from a composite material called G10. G10 is a type of high-pressure laminated fiberglass that is prized for its strength, durability, and resistance to water, solvents, and extreme temperatures. The material is also lightweight, making it a popular choice for tactical gear and shooting accessories.

G10 grips are often used to replace standard grips on various types of pistols, providing better grip and improved handling. They come in a variety of textures, from slightly grainy to very aggressive,

allowing users to choose the level of grip that works best for them. In addition to the functional enhancement, G10 grips can also add an aesthetic element to pistols, as they are available in a wide range of colors and patterns.

Increasingly popular in the United States, Kimber 1911 pistols made their debut in the early 2000s in the Hollywood film industry (John Wick 2, The Purge, Expendables, etc.), television (Breaking Bad, The Walking Dead, Yellowstone, etc.) and video games (Call of Duty: Modern Warfare, Ghost Recon, Far Cry 3, etc.).
