The AUG A3 SA M II is the civilian version of the famous STEYR AUG, a gas-operated semi-automatic rifle with a fixed slide and a QC (quick-change) barrel.

The Steyr AUG (Armee Universal Gewehr) is an iconic Austrian assault rifle, developed by Steyr Mannlicher in the late 1960s and adopted in 1978 by the Austrian Army. It is one of the first rifles to adopt a configuration **bullpup**, where the magazine and firing mechanism are located behind the grip and trigger, allowing for a more compact rifle without compromising barrel length. This innovative design made the Steyr AUG one of the most influential weapons in the development modern assault rifles.

- **Bullpup Design** : The bullpup allows for a reduction in the overall length of the weapon while maintaining a standard barrel length, providing excellent maneuverability, especially in urban or confined environments.
- **Versatility** : The Steyr AUG is modular and can be configured with different barrels (assault rifle, carbine, sniper rifle or light machine gun), making it extremely adaptable depending on the user's needs.
- **Polymer Construction** : The AUG popularized the use of polymer in firearm manufacturing, using lightweight, strong materials for the body of the weapon, making it a lightweight and sturdy weapon.

Ideal for sport shooting, competitions or law enforcement, this civilian version of the AUG remains faithful to the performance expected of this legendary weapon, combining precision, robustness and ease of use.
