The 1911 Kimber modernized with Optic Ready interface and GT Trigger.

The **Kimber Custom Two-Tone Next Gen** revisits the iconic 1911 design with a decidedly modern approach. Inheriting advancements developed for the **2K11** platform, this model combines classic aesthetics, match-grade performance, and optical compatibility in a particularly well-balanced configuration. Upon firing, the smoothness of the cycle and the crispness of the trigger pull are immediately apparent.

The **Kimber Custom Two-Tone Next Gen Optic Ready** combines the timeless elegance of the 1911 with technical advancements designed for modern shooters. Available in **9x19** and **.45 ACP**, it incorporates several innovations from the highly acclaimed Kimber 2K11 to offer a smoother, more versatile platform that is immediately ready to accept optics.

A modernized 1911 without losing its identity

Kimber retains the iconic lines of the 1911 while incorporating particularly relevant mechanical improvements. The external extractor enhances cycle reliability, while the new angled disconnect ramp promotes smoother operation.

In use, the operation feels smoother and more consistent - especially during fast-paced sequences. Nevertheless, it retains the typical feel of a true 1911, with that very direct control characteristic of the platform.

Optic Ready configuration and modern sighting

Optical compatible cylinder head

The receiver is machined to accept an **RMR Optic Plate** type base, allowing the installation of a red dot sight according to the shooter's needs. This configuration provides greater versatility without compromising the original mechanical components.

High-visibility sights

The pistol features a highly visible red front sight paired with a fixed black rear sight. This contrast facilitates rapid target acquisition, even in varying lighting conditions.

GT Trigger relaxation and match performance

The **GT Performance Trigger** offers a crisp break set between 4 and 5 pounds from the factory. This trigger pull greatly contributes to the accuracy potential of the Custom Two-Tone Next Gen. In practice, the race remains short and particularly clean. It's the kind of detail you notice immediately from the very first sets.

Stainless steel match barrel with 1:16" rifling

The 5-inch stainless steel barrel features a **1:16" left-hand twist rate** on both the 9x19 and .45 ACP versions. This configuration contributes to projectile stability while maintaining the characteristic performance desired on a modern 1911 platform.

Kimber premium finishes

The contrast between the **Satin Silver** stainless steel frame and the black **KimPro II** slide gives the pistol a very striking visual identity. The black walnut grips with G10 inserts provide excellent handling while reinforcing the overall premium look.

FAQ

Is the Kimber Custom Two-Tone Next Gen compatible with a red dot sight?

Yes. The pistol has an Optic Ready slide compatible with an RMR type base.

What calibers are available for this model?

The Kimber Custom Two-Tone Next Gen is offered in 9x19 and .45 ACP.

What is the rifling twist rate of the barrel?

Both versions feature a 1:16 inch stripe pitch with left-hand stripes.

What is the capacity of the chargers?

The 9x19 version has a 9-round magazine while the .45 ACP version comes with a 7-round magazine.
